Specificity and Sensitivity

GR (phospho-Ser211) antibody detects endogenous levels of GR only when phosphorylated at serine 211.

Source and Purification

The antiserum was produced against synthesized phosphopeptide derived from human GR around the phosphorylation site of serine 211 (N-E-S^P-P-W).

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

Application Notes

Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Suggested starting dilutions are as follows:

WB: 1: 500~1:3000 IHC: 1:50~1:100

ELISA: 1:5000

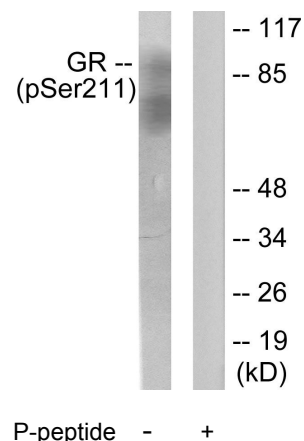
Storage Buffer

Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline (without Mg²⁺ and Ca²⁺), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.

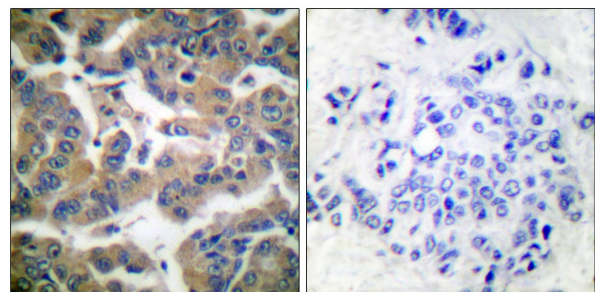
Storage Instructions

Stable for 1 year at -20°C from date of shipment. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the original vial after thawing and prior to removing the cap. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Aliquot will be stable at 4°C for 3 months.
