## Specificity and Sensitivity

Phospho-Ataxin 1 (Ser776) Antibody detects endogenous levels of Ataxin 1 only when phosphorylated at Serine 776.

## Source and Purification

A synthesized peptide derived from human Ataxin 1 around the phosphorylation site of Serine 776.

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

## Application Notes

Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Suggested starting dilutions are as follows:

WB: 1:500~1:3000 IF/ICC: 1:100-1:500

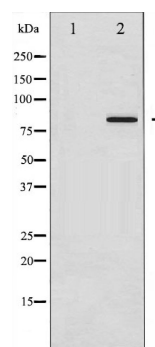
## Storage Buffer

Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline (without Mg<sup>2+</sup> and Ca<sup>2+</sup>), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.

## Storage Instructions

Stable for 1 year at -20°C from date of shipment. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the original vial after thawing and prior to removing the cap. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Aliquot will be stable at 4°C for 3 months.
